

3rd Carshalton Cubs Family Treasure Trail

This trail will guide you around the roads and parks of Carshalton Village. It is roughly 3.5km long and should take a couple of hours to complete.

Your start point is at Carshalton Methodist Church on Ruskin Road.

Clue 1

What year did C Spencer Knight lay his stone at Carshalton Methodist Church?

Turn left into The Park and walk up keeping Carshalton Park on your left.

Clue 2

What colour is the front door of 13 The Park?

Clue 3

Look for this telegraph pole on the right outside the park fence. What are the missing letters?



Continue up The Park

Clue 4

What are the words on the plaque beneath this one?



Turn left into Ashcombe Rd and continue walking, keeping the park on your left. Turn left into the park through the last gate.

Clue 5

How many small archways are there in the bottom wall of the Grotto?

Follow the path alongside the playground to the tennis courts, then veer right around them and exit the park onto Ruskin Rd.

Clue 6

How many swings (baby & child) are there in the playground?

Cross the road and walk straight on along the canal path to Talbot Rd, turn right and walk to Rotherfield Rd. Turn left and walk towards Carshalton High St.

Clue 7

How many yellow pencils are alongside the barriers outside the main entrance of All Saints Primary School?

Turn right and cross the road using the Toucan crossing. Turn right into Westcroft Rd and follow it round to the Leisure Centre.

Clue 8

Look out for this sign. How many miles to Wandsworth if you are cycling?



Clue 9

On the purple notice board what is the 4th service listed in the right hand column?

Turn left and walk across the wooden bridge into Grove Park. Follow the path round to the Bowls Club.

Clue 10

How much does it cost for an adult to play bowls for an hour?

Follow the main path and turn right, keeping the playground on your left hand side.

Clue 11

What is the upper age limit for children to play in the playground?

Continue down the path and fork left to walk along the river, go across the bridge at the waterfall and follow the path around to Stone Court House.

Exit the park at these gates and cross North Street using the zebra crossing. Turn left and walk towards the ponds.

Clue 12

What number buses stop here?



Turn right into Honeywood Walk and continue walking towards the Ecology Centre.


Clue 13

How many Browns were killed in the wars?

Clue 14

What part of the Ecology Centre has been blanked out on this map?



Take the path in between Honeywood Museum and the Ecology Centre (Festival Walk) and follow it to West Street.

Clue 15

How tall was the London Plane Tree in March 1984

Cross the road and turn left, after looking up at the Water Tower.

Clue 16

What part of the Water Tower is open from May to September?

Walk to Pound Street and turn right, with the wall to St Philomena's High School on your right hand side. Walk up to the crossroads where the Windsor Castle Pub sits.

Clue 17

Look out for a red plaque on a wall. What date was Carshalton House built?

Carefully cross the road at these crossroads and walk up Park Hill, keeping a look out for Sutton's only blue plaque on one of the houses on the right.

Clue 18

Who lived here?

At this house cross over the road and head back towards Carshalton. Turn right into Wales Ave and then left into Carshalton Park Rd.

Carry on towards the Methodist Church and take the road opposite (Carshalton Park Road) heading back down towards Carshalton.

Turn right into the churchyard and follow the path round to All Saints Church, looking out for a plaque dedicated to Rev'd Leigh Edwards as you go.

Clue 19

How many trees were planted into the churchyard in 1998?

Go through the side gate at the right of the church and turn left to join the High Street.

Clue 20

What year was this stone laid?



Turn right into the High Street, walk past the Woodman and Coach & Horses pubs and then turn right into The Square.

Clue 21

Who was Vice Chairman of Carshalton Urban District Council at the time of the opening of Carshalton Library in 1908?

Continue up The Square to Talbot Rd, turn right and carry on until you arrive back at Carshalton Methodist Church.
